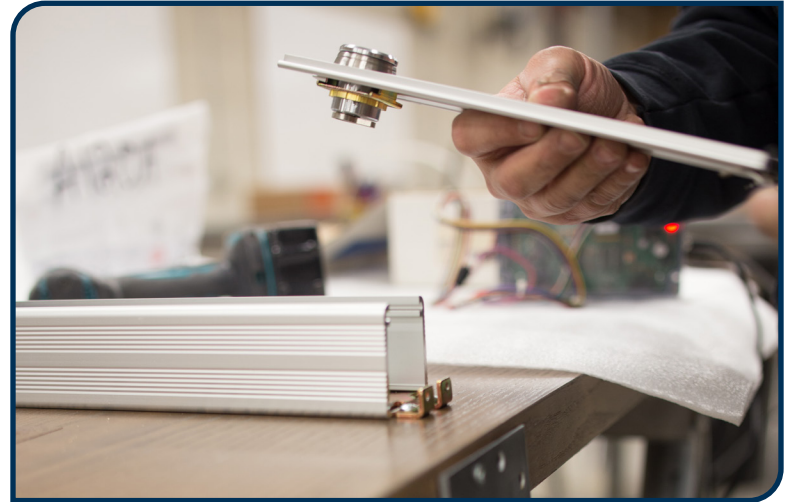


PRE-INSTALLATION QUALITY ASSURANCE

Pre installation is the process in which hardware such as hinges, door closers, exit devices, locks, electrified hardware, and flat goods are installed onto doors prior to shipping to the jobsite.



Ways we ensure the quality of materials delivered to the jobsite:

- Inspection of doors and hardware by experienced experts at multiple stages in the process. Factory errors can be spotted and corrected in a timely manner before material is on site.
- LaForce pre-installers are manufacturer certified and will take care of all the labeling, measuring, connecting, and testing of the hardware, including electrified hardware, to ensure quality and accuracy prior to the doors being shipped.
- Installers coordinate directly with LaForce's assigned project team, including the project engineer and project manager.
- Strict adherence to the approved door hardware schedule, installation instructions, and industry standards or established standards for the project.
- Prior to shipping, the doors are carefully stacked with spacers, corner guards, and shrink-wrapped to avoid any damage. We also attach the directions, strike plates, screws, and any extra hardware to the corresponding door – making it easy for delivery, organization, and onsite installation.
- For safety and quality reasons we package a maximum of 8-10 doors per skid.
- Once on the jobsite, our custom engineered skids can be accessed from all 4-sides by a fork lift or pallet jack, making the delivery of the doors from the truck to the appropriate openings quick and easy.
